PARENTS:

- Remember your children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Encourage children to participate, do not force them.
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Remember that children learn by example. Applaud good play by both teams.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse.
- Respect umpire's decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- You are there to enjoy your child's game. You are not there to coach! We have appointed coaches who are there to give instructions.
- Encourage your child to go directly to the coach at breaks and at end of the game.
- Leave either side of score bench for coach and players.
- Encourage your child to always participate according to the rules.
- If you have any concerns issues please put them in writing and give to a committee member to be dealt with by a full committee at an upcoming meeting.
- Show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them your child could not participate.
- As parents the proper procedure if you have any issue is to be put them in writing to the Gold Eagles committee. The committee can then raise issue with CSWNA. Parents should not approach the office directly.
